


Two Must-Read Books by Bob Miller


Anyone who has been attending our reunions has had the rare opportunity to meet this truly extraordinary man. I always look to an author's credentials to see if this type of book is impartially researched and sufficient reliable data is found to support the topic. You will find this is true in both of these books, and the subject matter in each case is vitally important to be a well-informed human being. Bob has not taken little topics and explored them. These are serious topics which will richly enlighten you in areas that we usually pass over because the press has almost totally ignored them.

The Z-5 incident takes us back to the final weeks of WWII in Europe. Allied POW's in Eastern Europe were expecting that the approaching end of the war would free them to return to their homelands. Instead, the Soviets hauled them off to the Gulag camps and their story was never heard. This is an incredible cover up by our government until a rare escape by one of the prisoners returned home to tell his story of those accountable for his betrayal. "Uncle Joe" proved to be more barbaric than anyone could imagine, and we did nothing, even though we had the lists of the prisoners and what POW camp Germany had placed them in. You must remember that the Germans were meticulous in keeping records for their 1000year Reich! Don't let Bob's efforts slide by the wayside and be forgotten. You must read this book!

America's Abandoned Sons could not have a better title. The quote from the cover, "THE UNTOLD STORY OF THOUSANDS OF US SOLDIERS SECRETLY MURDERED IN THE USSR", is enough to get the ire up in any veteran. We all risked our lives for what we believed were causes worth the risk. These soldiers went into battle the same way we started out. Only they were up against a stacked deck out of "diplomatic" and "strategic" decisions naively made. Quoting from Bob, "A myth is a statement of ostensible historical events concerning a practice, a belief, or a natural phenomenon. The United States Government's position regarding the possibility that significant numbers of American servicemen were ever held as prisoners of war or missing in action (POW/MIA), in the twentieth century, is that it is a myth." With this mindset and a totally ignorant understanding of the Soviet and the Nazi minds, we as a country are morally deficient in not at least making this all well-known. Become informed. Challenge your minds to look at this travesty. These were real people. They deserve more than the oblivion that surrounds them. Think how many families never got "closure."

Both of these books stemmed out of WWII. That's a long time ago. BUT! Think what is happening in China and Russia and Syria and Afghanistan, to name just a few. I witnessed Hong Kong just before the handover and just after. Before was total freedom. Immediately after takeover, personal freedom was gone. I saw it happen within feet of me on a main Hong Kong street. Don't be uninformed about the direction the world is going.

Therefore, I further recommend a book titled "The Naked Communist" by W. Cleon Skousen.



With the dangerous direction that some in this country are saying that we must move, we must understand the consequences if that happens. If you read this book, you will find out about agreements made in and reinforced at the end of WWII. Yes, that is 74 years ago, but our enemies are patient. Do we want to be in a situation like the POW/MIA's found themselves? Do we want books like these written about us? Be informed about our adversaries. Don't look to the TV for reality. Trust but verify. Verify by becoming informed.



It never ceases to amaze me to discover the incredible range of talents that the personnel of AFTAC possess! Military leaders, scientists, authors, entrepreneurs, athletes, public servants, university professors, charity leaders and many more! This article is about Jack O'Connor, author and humanitarian. Jack went through Lowry AFB in 1955, which put him just steps, literally, ahead of me as I spent a couple of months on hold starting the end of September '55 awaiting class assignment. Jack could never have foreseen the series of events that took him to this particular mission.

Jack says, "That title is about a mission I led into Hanoi to bring out the first twelve of those POWs who died in captivity in North Vietnam. Of course, in 414 pages it has several other previously untold stories including five chapters on the old 1009th SWS (Now AFTAC) in the mid-50's. They are some pretty interesting stories in WB 29's & WB-50's as well as RB-36 in our efforts to collect Russian debris. It also has stories on how there was no way I should have lived through about nine experiences, one in the 1009th.
